Last year, the dinner raised over \$340,000 for the TNYF which contributed to providing more than 7,500 summer camp day experiences at Camp Manitou, offering the Project 11 curriculum to 1,200 classrooms, and allowing more than 825 children to participate in the Winnipeg Jets Hockey Academy.



How does the True North Youth Foundation empower potential?

The True North Youth Foundation promotes the growth and development of young people by delivering programs that assist underserved youth in Manitoba and provide educational opportunities that help build life skills and shape character while promoting physical and mental wellness. The TNYF prides itself on creating meaningful opportunities for youth by offering learning and adventure, celebrating inclusion, and providing an opportunity to cultivate connections, self-esteem, and physical, intellectual and social skillsets.

Thousands of children are empowered to realize their full potential through TNYF's three continuously growing programs which guide youth on a journey of self-discovery in a safe and caring environment that allows young people to be themselves and experience a high degree of independence.





The Winnipeg Jets Hockey Academy enables over 825 youth who have few recreational options to participate in a hockey skills program that incorporates community volunteers and university students as instructors and positive role models. The program offers both a daytime and after school component which enables students from Grade 2 through high school to both learn the basics of hockey and take advantage of opportunities that support their academics. The WJHA is about more than hockey; the program fosters leadership and citizenship as student athletes are shown many different possibilities for their future through an assortment of field trips, visits to post-secondary institutions, career counselling and various volunteer opportunities.



Project 11 is a curricular resource available to schools in Manitoba for kindergarten to Grade 8. Over 1,200 classrooms participate in the program which teaches resiliency and positive coping skills. Through Project 11 the classroom becomes a community where students learn about and openly discuss mental wellness.






